 Inside you will find photographs, documents, hand-written registers and journals dating back to 1905. Entry fee applies.
- Axel Stenross Maritime Museum Fantastic historical collection of all things boating which offers a unique journey back in time. Entry fee applies. Approx 2.2 km from the town jetty.




