

CITY HIGHLIGHTS

While in town there is much you can see and do on foot.

- **Hotel Boston Markets** – As you walk along the Parnkalla Trail into town, the Hotel Boston is your first stop on the left! Enjoy local markets, live entertainment, and all-day dining – all while overlooking beautiful Boston Bay.
- **Cruise Ship Markets – Anglican Church** – Local stall holders forming a market village on the Anglican Church lawns.
- **Nautilus Art Centre** – Contains a gallery and gift shop with works from our talented local artists and artisans. Artworks and handicrafts are available for purchase.
- **RSL CLUB Military** – Browse the military museum or enjoy a drink at the bar. Entry fee for the museum applies.
- **The Old Mill** is a fantastic location to visit, with 180 degree views over Boston Bay.
- **The Mill Cottage** in Flinders Park contains a collection of displays, furniture and clothing from the Bishop Family brought over from England in 1839. Entry fee applies.
- **Railway Museum** is ideal for history buffs interested in the history and nostalgia of rail. Inside you will find photographs, documents, hand-written registers and journals dating back to 1905. Entry fee applies.
- **Axel Stenross Maritime Museum** – Fantastic historical collection of all things boating which offers a unique journey back in time. Entry fee applies. Approx 2.2 km from the town jetty.

Tours available to be booked at the Visitor Information Centre.

- Take in the highlights of Port Lincoln and surrounding area with guided tours to Lincoln National Park.
- A 'Seafood-Lovers' guided, behind the scenes factory tour and tasting at The Fresh Fish Place.
- Seafood Bay Cruise – see the bay and learn about our fishing industry including our local history.
- Make amazing memories with a 'Swim with the Sea Lions' half day tour.
- Relax and enjoy a comfortable personal discovery of Port Lincoln's seafood industry on board Fred's Marina Canal Cruise.
- Hire electric mountain bikes to see the local sights at your own pace.
- Coffin Bay Oyster Farm Tours – only tour of it's kind in the world where you can sit in the water and taste fresh oysters straight out of the sea!
- Kimbrella Walking Tours – Stroll along the foreshore learning unique local information.
- Step on board Port Lincoln's most historical tuna clipper – MFV Tacoma.



TOWN SHUTTLE BUS

Operates between the Wharf and the CBD.
Look for the blue town shuttle bus flag.

First bus departs the Wharf at 8:45am.
Last bus departs the CBD at 4:00pm.

Return ticket from the Wharf to the CBD.
\$10.00 adult (12+), \$7.00 child (4 - 12),
under 4 on lap free, \$30.00 family (2A + 2C).

DECEMBER & JANUARY CRUISE SHIPS:

Times: 9:30am-4:30pm, departs every 30 minutes.
Last loop departs the RSL at 3:30pm.

FEBRUARY AND MARCH CRUISE SHIPS:

Times: 9:30am-3:00pm, departs every 30 minutes.
Last loop departs the RSL at 2:00pm.
