Australian Coastal Safari

Visitors can swim and interact with playful Australian sea lions. These creatures are often called the "puppies of the sea" due to their friendly and curious nature.

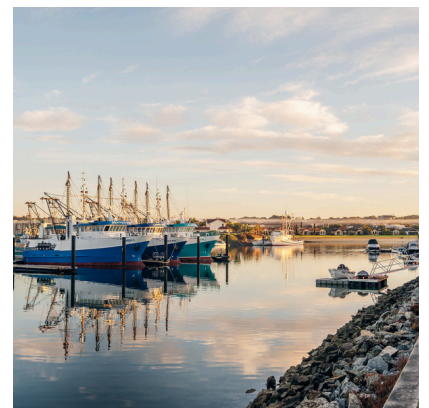


Seafood Bay Cruise*

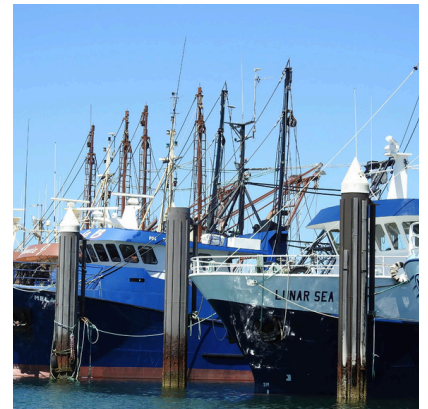
MFV Tacoma

Port Lincoln Fishing Charters

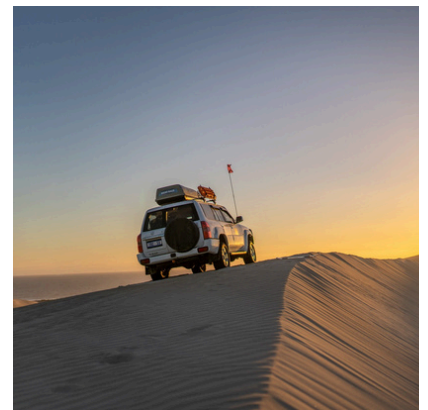

Oyster Farm Tours

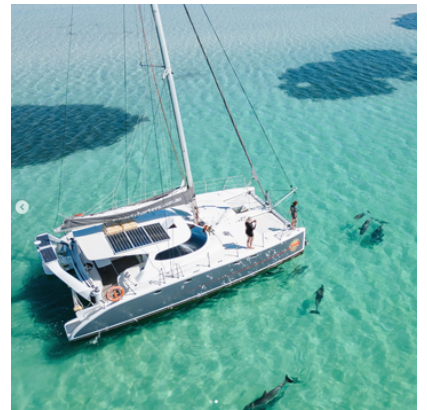

MUSEUMS

Axel Stenross Maritime Museum



Showcases the region's rich maritime history, featuring historic boats, shipbuilding tools, and artifacts from the early fishing and sailing industries, all set in the original boatyard of Finnish boatbuilder Axel Stenross.



Mill Cottage Museum



Offers a glimpse into the region's early settler history, showcasing artifacts, memorabilia, and historic furnishings from the 19th century in the original family home of pioneer Captain John Bishop.

Railway Museum



Preserves the history of the region's railway system, featuring vintage locomotives, carriages, and a collection of railway memorabilia, offering insights into the role of rail in Port Lincoln's development.

Please call ahead if needing ramps for wheelchair access.



RSL Military Display



Honours the region's military history with an extensive collection of artifacts, uniforms, medals, and personal stories from local servicemen and women, providing a moving tribute to those who served in Australia's armed forces.

A vibrant cultural hub, showcasing local and national art exhibitions, live performances, and community events in a historic venue.



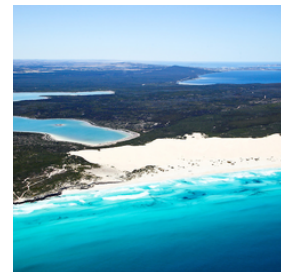

Features rugged coastal landscapes, secluded beaches, and diverse wildlife, making it perfect for hiking, camping, and nature enthusiasts.



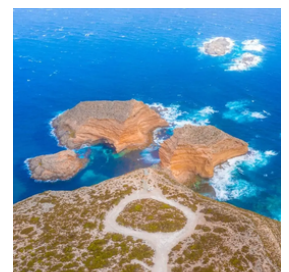
Mikkira Station

A peaceful sanctuary home to wild koalas, kangaroos, and emus. It offers camping, historic ruins, and beautiful natural surroundings.



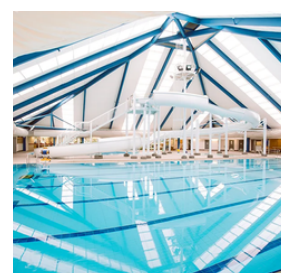
Whalers Way

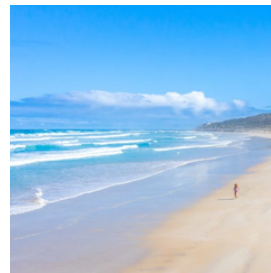
Offering a fully equipped gym, indoor swimming pools, and fitness classes, perfect for staying active while on the road.

First Landing Site

Honours those lost at sea, serving as a tribute to the region's fishing heritage. It's located on the waterfront, offering a peaceful spot for reflection.



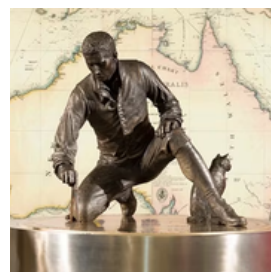
Makybe Diva Statue

Oyster Walk- Coffin Bay

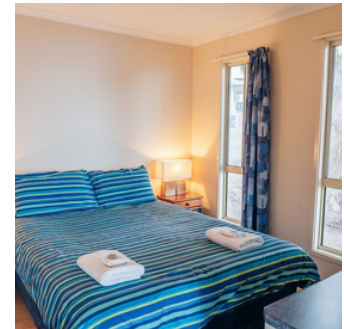

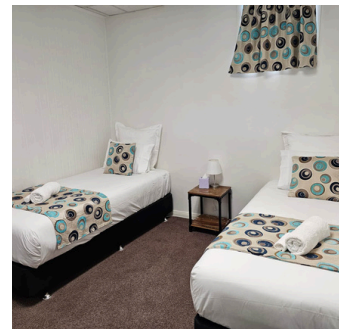
